# Thomas Phillips Dr

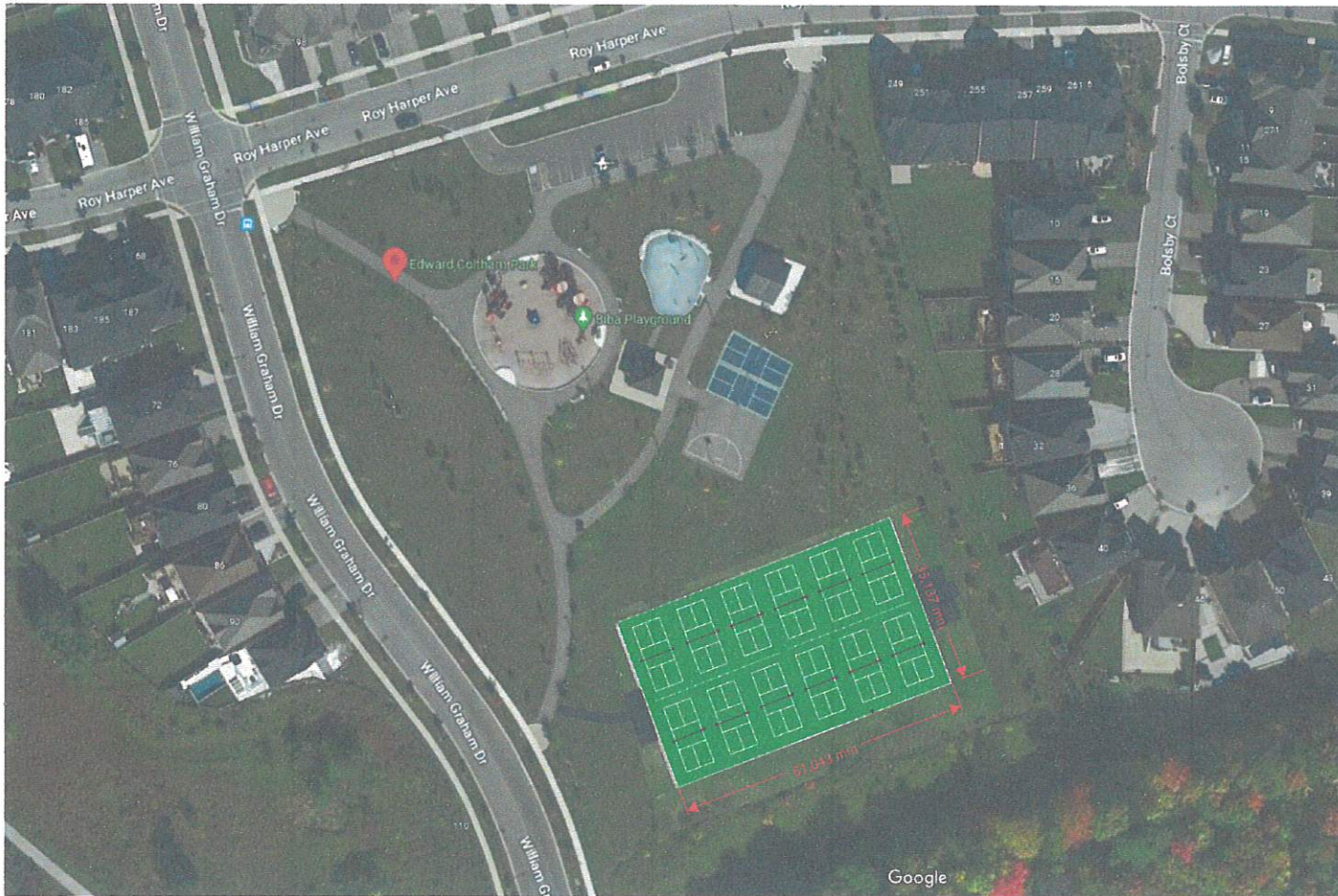


Thomas Phillips Pickleball courts are existing asphalt that have no fence around them. How do you expect us to play on these courts, we are not going to run around to pick up ball and interfere with the basketball player's, this is not safe. The grass to asphalt edge is a tripping hazard, before you fall into the swale.

The lines are in poor condition as there has been a lack of maintenance.

An 8 ft high fence needs to be installed, with one man gate. then a Plexipave coloured surface can be applied the following year. This will help with the major Pickleball court shortage.

The existing Pickleball courts here are a disgrace and should be changed to Road Tennis as they are unsafe to play on. No Fence and a tripping hazard at court edge.
