
## **Community Partnerships**

These partnerships allow us to provide multilingual programming to newcomers, in addition to arts and cultural experiences.




# **Key Performance Indicators Programs (YTD Sept)**

48% increase in program attendance (2022 - 2023)












## **Key Performance Indicators Circulation (YTD Sept)**








# **Key Performance Indicators In-Person Visits (YTD Sept)**
