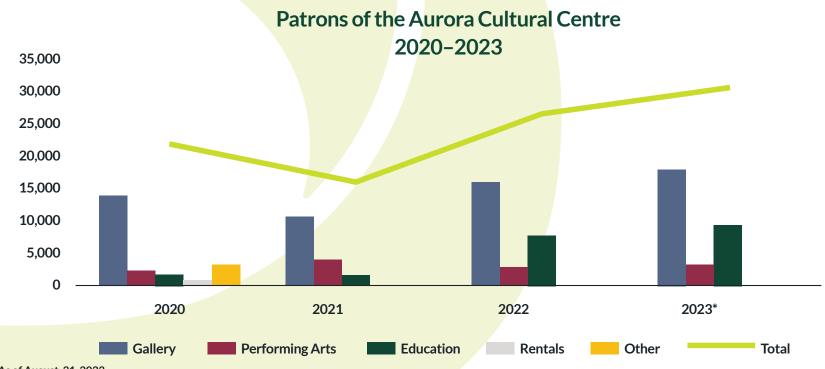

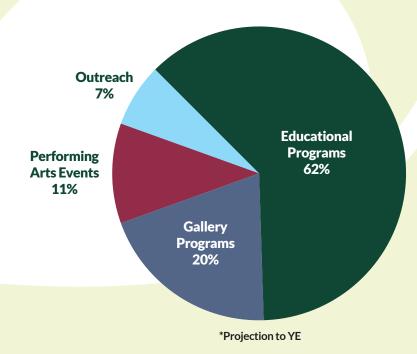

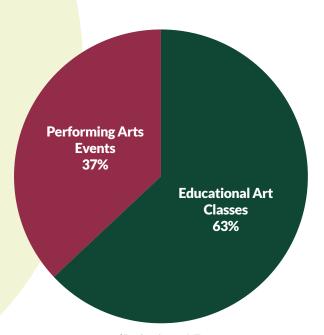
Types of Activation*

Direct Revenue*

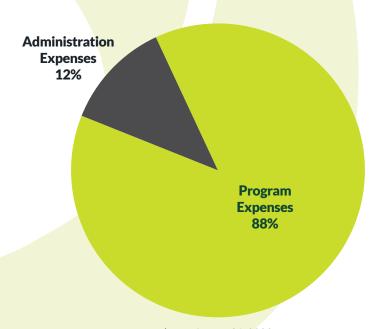
