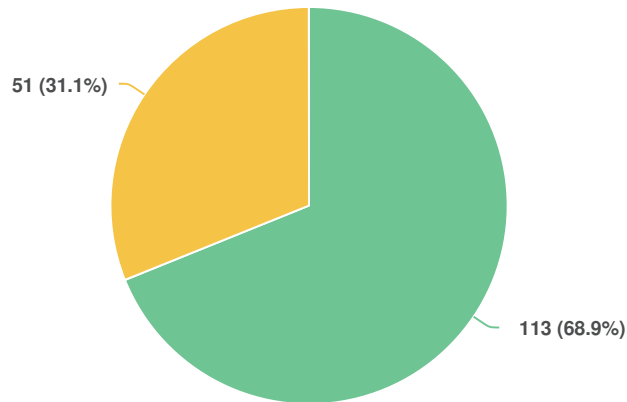

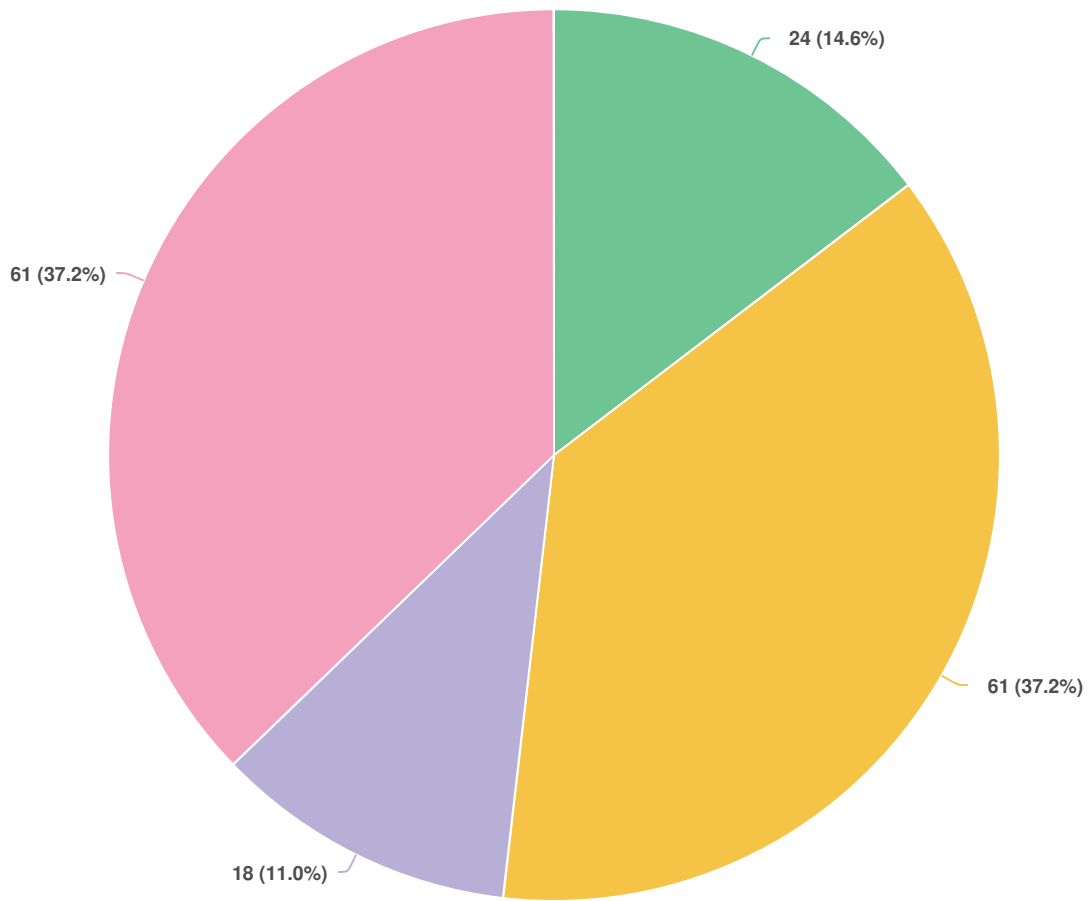

**Q2** How many times have you visited the Hillary House?

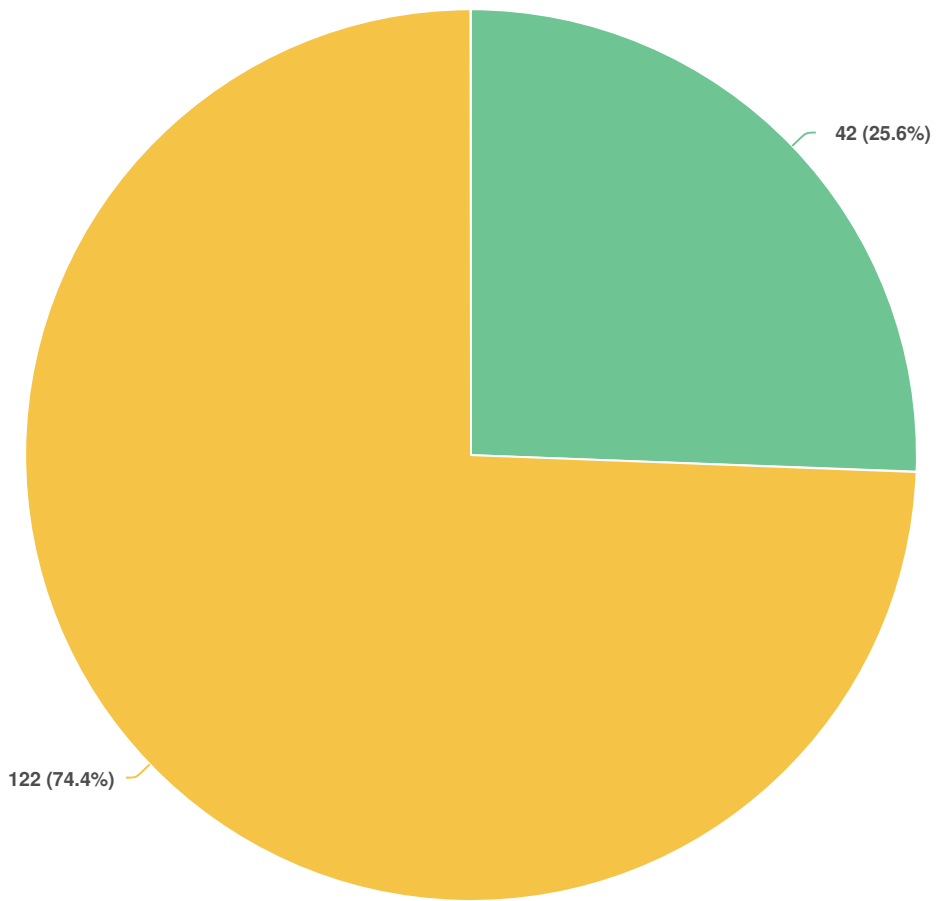

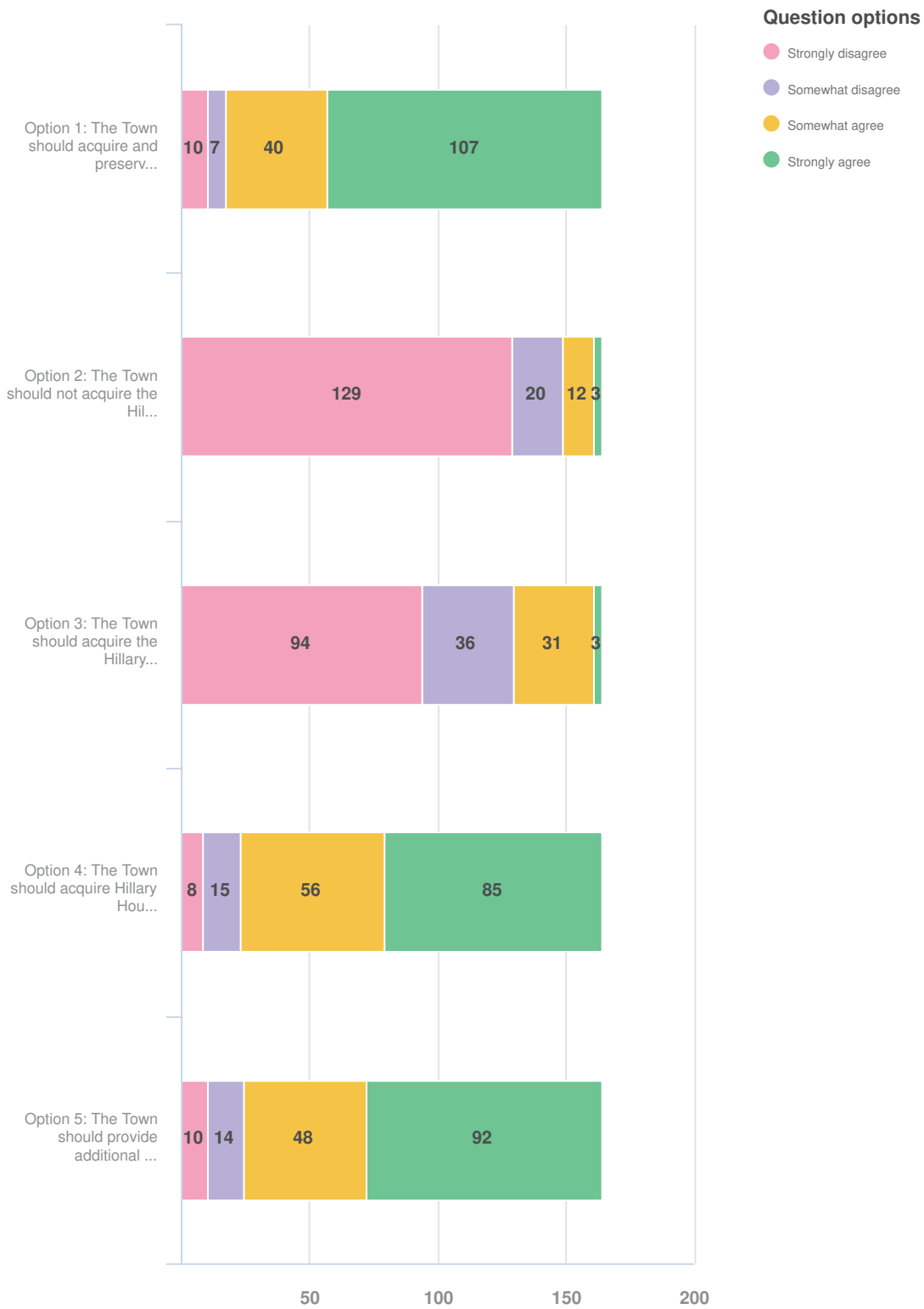

**Q4** Indicate your level of support for the following options

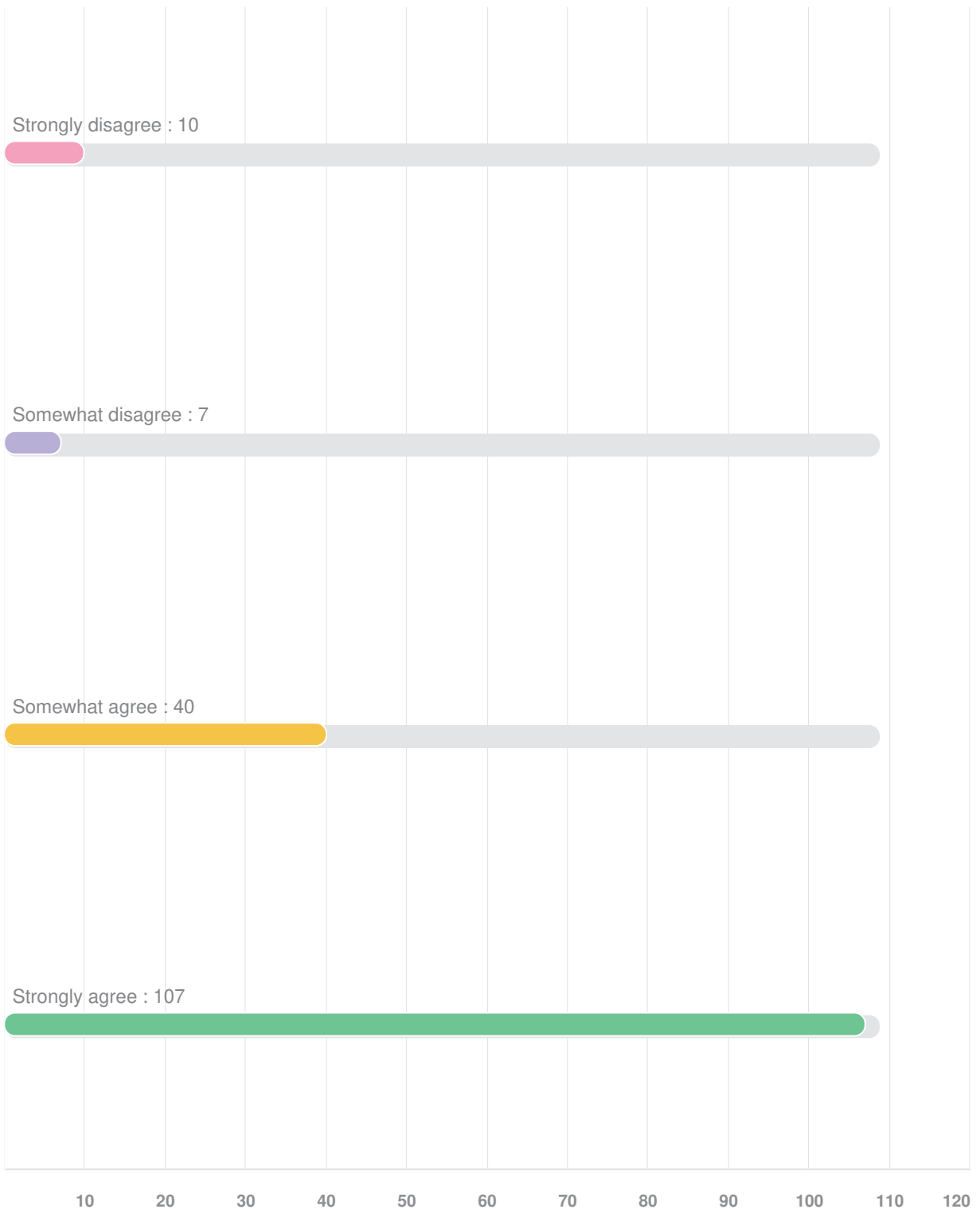

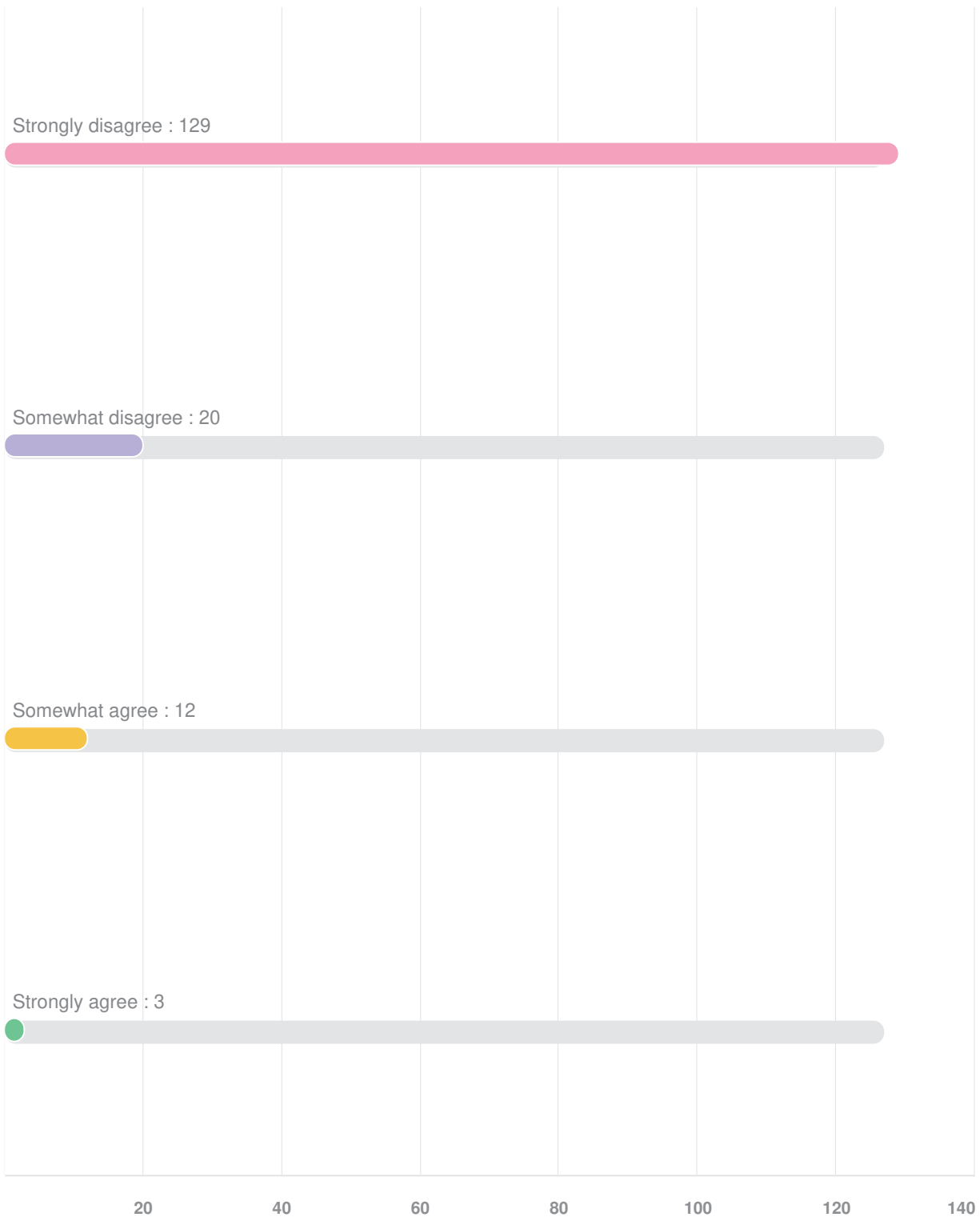
**Option 1: The Town should acquire and preserve the Hillary House. (Current estimated costs to repair and preserve the Hillary House are around \$2M. )**



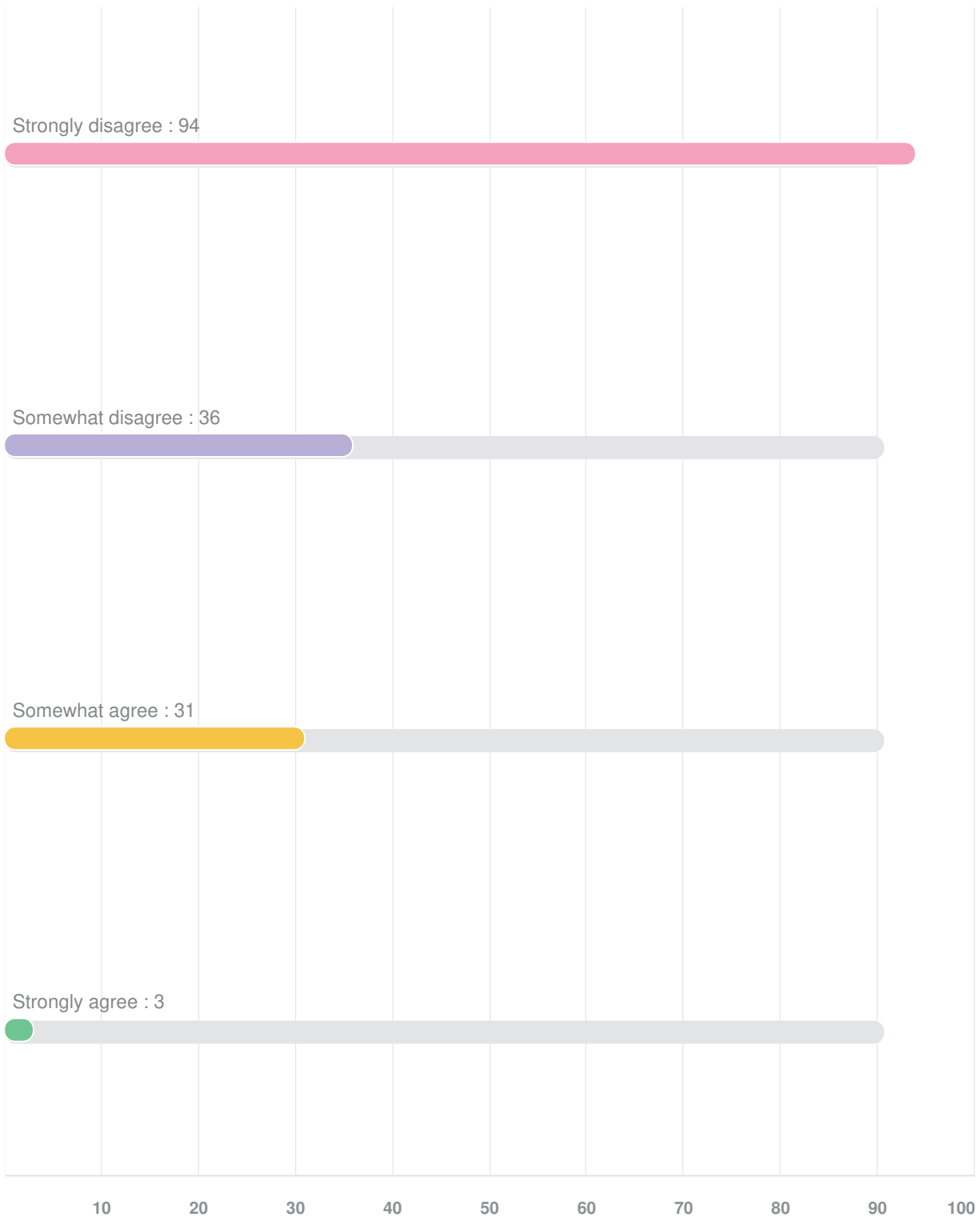




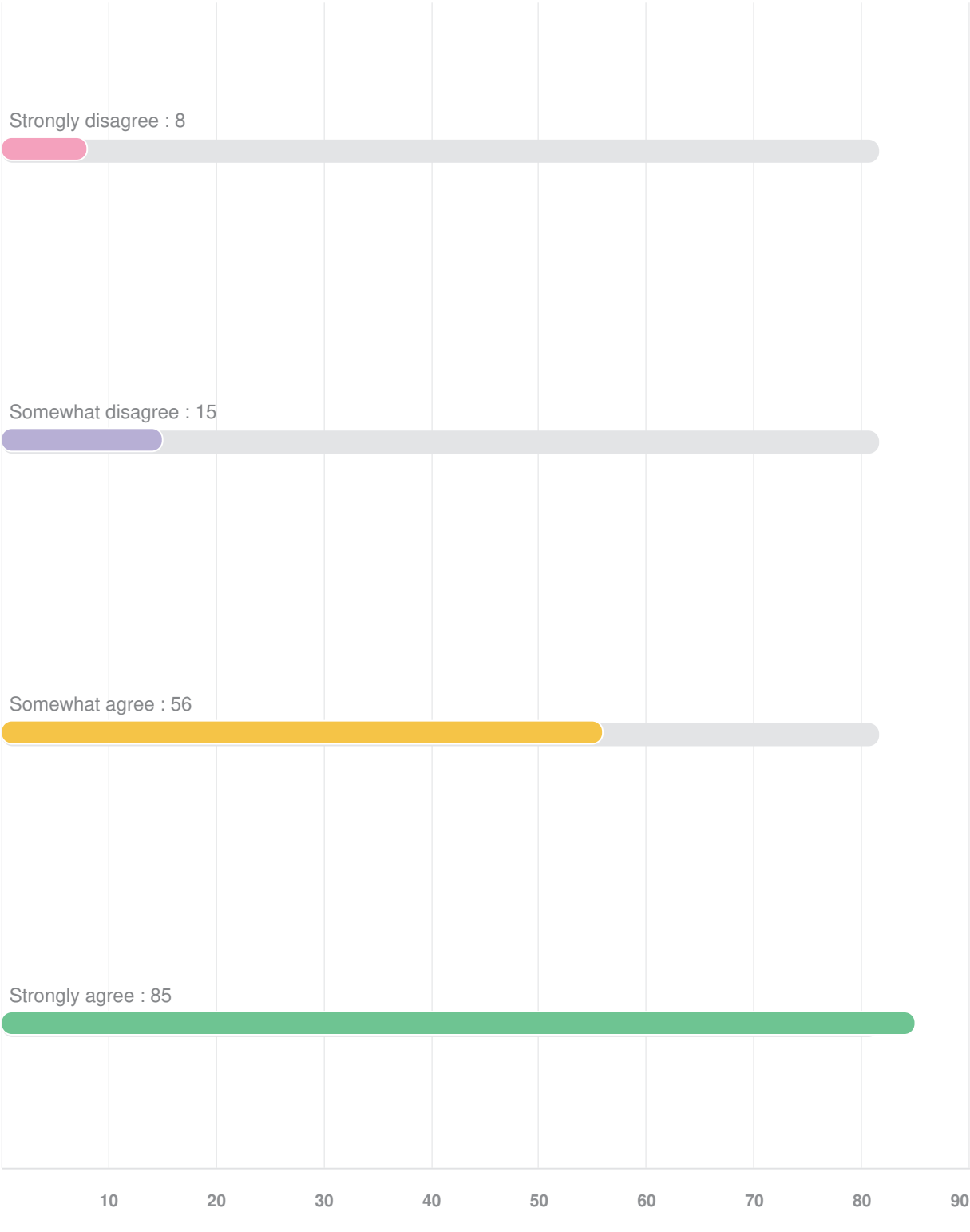
**Option 2: The Town should not acquire the Hillary House and instead encourage the AHS to seek alternative solutions, which may include selling the property on the open market.**
