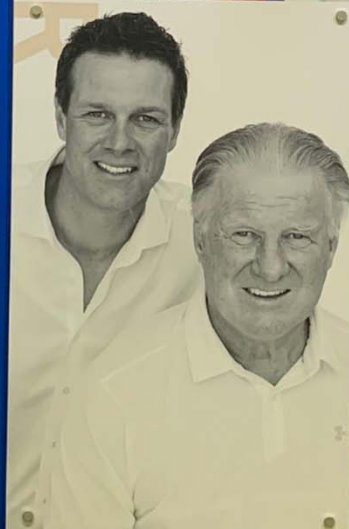

# Sport History Alive Program.



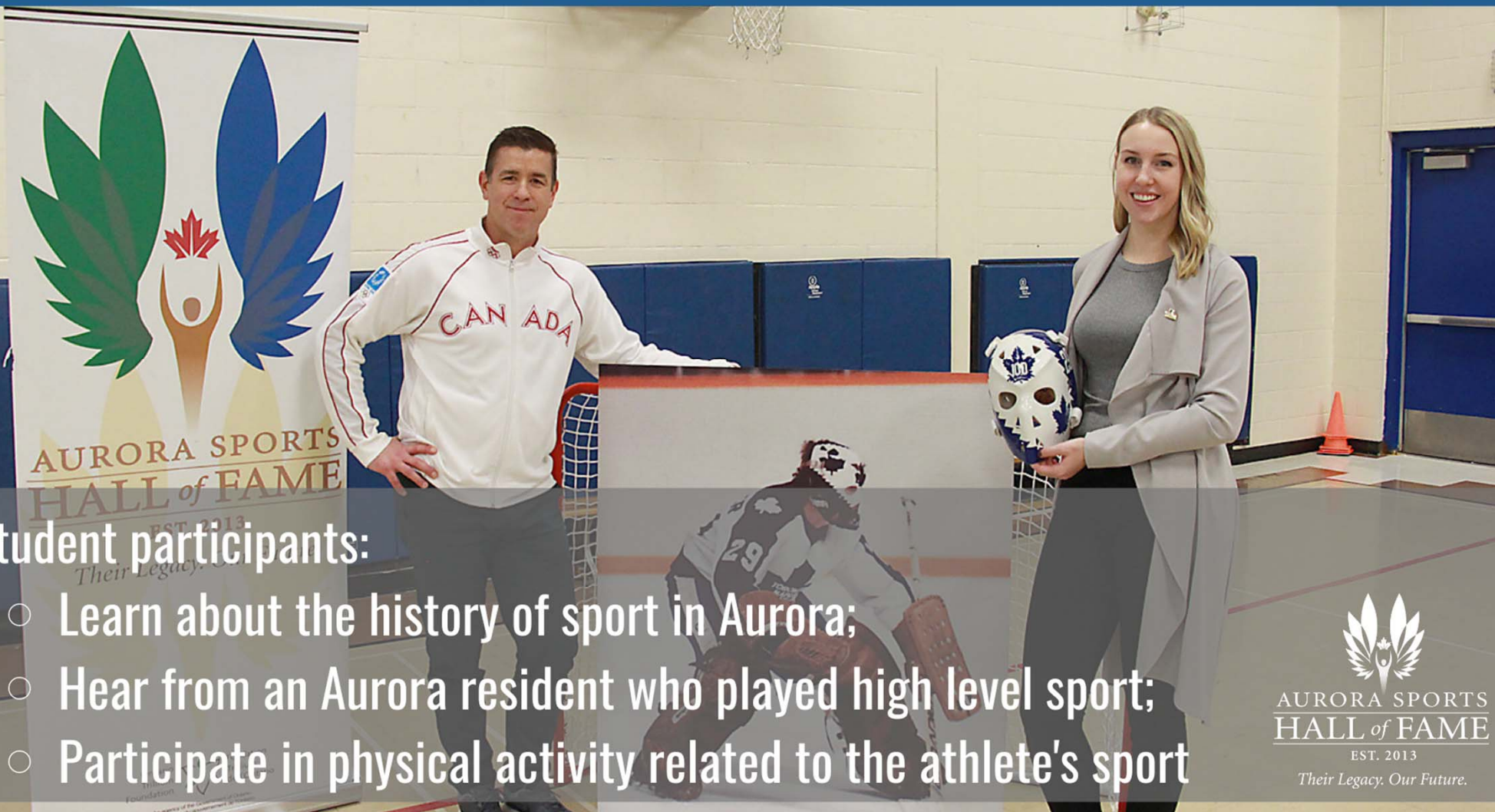
- 60 minute in-class, interactive program designed to bring Aurora's rich athletic history alive for elementary students and educators.

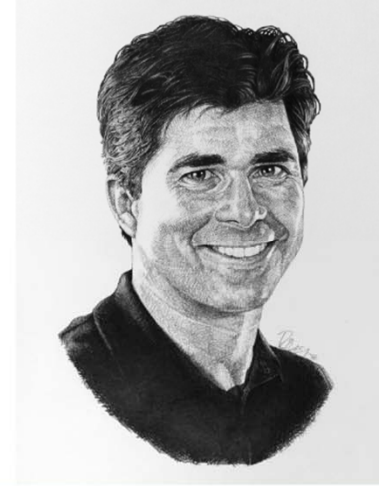
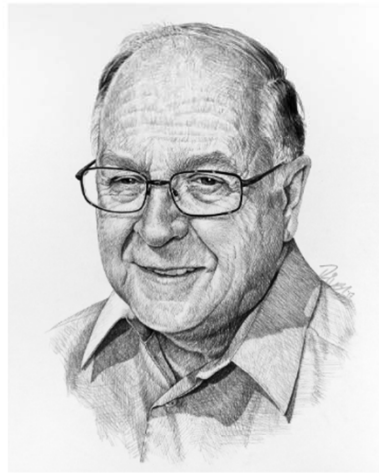
