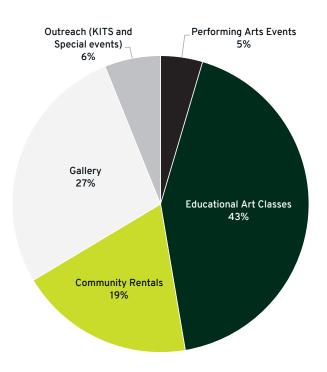

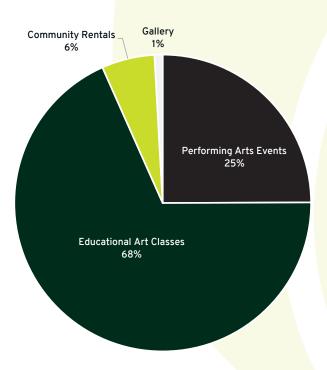

Types of Activation

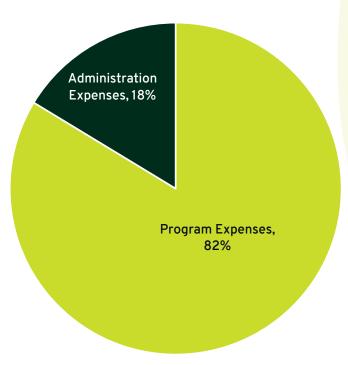


Direct Revenue
